Dear reader,

The fourth and final project meeting of **DIGIT-ALL** project took place in Bratislava, Slovakia, from 26th to 27th of October.

At this meeting, the partners discussed the latest procedures for the last project results. The implementation for the online courses is already in its final stages, so they will soon be available on the platform for those interested.





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The **DIGIT-ALL** project, by providing free access to three online courses will provide the adult population with few digital skills the possibility to develop level two skills according to the *DigComp* structure¹, which allows them to use digital equipment safely.

In course 1, the theme is security and aims at cybersecurity with special attention to the protection: devices, personal data, health, well-being, and the environment. Information and Literacy are themes available in course 2 that allow trainees to develop skills related to research, analysis and evaluation of data, information and digital content. In the third course, aspects related to online Communication and Collaboration are developed, namely interacting, sharing, collaborating, participating in citizenship and managing digital identity, themes of high relevance to today's society. The structure of these courses includes at the end of each theme a practical exercise and a questionnaire that allows the trainee to verify his level of knowledge of the contents presented in each course as well a questionnaire for the feedback of the courses by the trainees.

This resource will be available for 3 years after the end of the project and can be attended by any interested person, as well as entities that develop requalification and training programs for adults with low level of knowledge and digital skills.
